In addition, you have the opportunity to compete in **four** exciting races, and to win **four** separate trophies, including an elegant CORUM Admiral's Cup timepiece for the overall winner in each class. If time will not permit you to enjoy this experience in its entirety, read on...

If you are a fervent weekend racer, with not much time to be away from work, or think Ensenada is not a true test, then this race series is for you. The first race to Cedros Island is 375 miles in length and just 2½ days. You can opt to finish after the first Awards Party at Turtle Bay, or choose to race another 218 miles to the second race finish and Awards Party near Magdalena Bay, home of the fantastic whale migration. You then can choose to race to Cabo (and lay over at the new marina at San Jose del Cabo), or return home from any race terminus earlier...or, what the Hell...go all the way to P.V. (Good Choice!)

If you are a to-and-from Catalina Island sailor with dreams of venturing further, then this race series is for you. You do not need a high tech, tricked-out boat (not even a spinnaker) to participate in the **Non-Spinnaker Division**. Three enjoyable and informative preparation seminars provide you with the necessary information and guidance to easily equip your boat and plan your voyage. Twice daily communication with a well-equipped escort vessel, and with the other race participants, provides safety and security. The frequent contact with the fleet at sea and at onshore parties, plus the beauty of the anchorages and the majesty of the marine life, make this race series a life-time memory.
